Following is an updated comparison of school tax levies in each of Hamilton County's twenty-three school districts by County Auditor Dusty Rhodes.

"This allows residents to determine where their district now ranks among the County's districts in terms of actual tax cost," said Rhodes. Formerly all that could be compared were tax millage rates which require various conversions to arrive at readily understandable numbers.

Following are the schools' portion of the total property tax bill paid by an owner-occupied residence for each \$100,000 of market value.
